Minutes of March 18, 2022 Meeting

President Dona S. started the meeting at 6:30 and welcomed everyone.

She wished happy March Birthdays to: Susan B., Sherise B., Sophie K., JoAnn M., Dina N., Rita R., Laurie S., and Ruth S.

Dona asked for there were any amendments or corrections needed for the February meeting minutes published online? Hearing none, she asked for a motion to approve them as written. Said motion made by Juanita G. and seconded by Diane C. Motion approved with a call of ayes from the membership.

The Treasurer's Report was read by Debbie P. The Ending balance was 10,058.93. Dona asked for a motion to approve them as written. Said motion made by Ginger C. and seconded by Kathy M. Motion approved with a call of ayes from the membership.

• **Charity Quilts** (Carol C./Juanita G).Carol dropped off 12 quilts with DCP&P and plans to bring more in April. Juanita had gotten a special request for a Red, White & Blue Quilt for a 98-year-old gentleman, and asked if anyone had one for donation. She suggested maybe that was a color scheme to keep in mind when making charity quilts

Quilt Show 2022 reports:

Dona indicated there were sign-up sheets on the front table for working admissions at the show. Shifts will be in two-hour increments and if there are not enough sign-ups members will be conscripted at the show.

Raffle Quilts ticket money should be turned in to Donna D. Donna said she is keeping a distribution list as required by the state. New Jersey requires all fundraising documents to be held for possible inspection for three years. Donna D will email those with outstanding tickets, they must be returned, sold or not.

Erma H. said there were 100 quilts, the max, registered for the show. She reminded everyone that on drop-off day, the quilts must be folded backside up and label area on top. Registrars will check that the label is covered, and if not, the owner will be given needle, thread and muslin to do so. Failure to comply with this rule will constitute a withdrawal from the show. Intake is from 9 am -1pm Wednesday, and make sure you get a receipt for each quilt you drop off. The receipts are needed for pick up on Sunday, AFTER 5 pm.

Jackie P. asked all the Country Store volunteers to be there Friday at 10am to start set up. If all go well she may offer presales to members at the end of the day Friday.

Ellen H. has a judging day protocol Zoom meeting scheduled 03/25/22. Be there or chair the show next year!

Laurie S. said that she has placed an ad in **The Country Register**, which will reach New Jersey and Pennsylvania Markets. She received free copies which she left at Crafty Fabrics and Mouse Creek Quilts. The ad has a \$1.00 off discount to be collected at the admissions desk to judge it's effectiveness.

Dona S. reminded everyone that there is no April meeting or newsletter because of the Quilt Show.

Dina N. announced that on June 25th and 26th Historic Cold Spring Village will be having a quilt show, and members of Beachplum can participate. Dina will be judging this event, so if you're going to enter, please don't bring that entry in for Beachplum's "show and tell" prior to the Cold Spring Village event in June.

Dona S. Reminded everyone of the Global Quilt Connection You Tube event coming up Saturday and Sunday. The shows will be available to watch for 24 hours after the initial airing.

• Judging of Show Challenge (Ellen H./Jane S.) The Sunbonnet Sue Quilt Challenge entries were displayed and the membership viewed them to vote. It was not an easy task due to the outstanding creativity and workmanship of all the entries! There was a tie for first place, so by a show of hands those two entries were voted on again. The results: 1st Place-Joyce Weiss-*"Keep Your Paws Off the Quilts"*; 2nd Place-Dixie Moore-*"Sunbonnet Sue"*; 3rd Place-Debbie Perks-*"Sunbonnet Sue and Her Cat Buttons go to the Quilt Show"* All the delightful entries will be on display at the show.

- Block of the Month (Dixie M./Marcia G.) The 18 "Woven" block submitted were won by Jane S.
- Door Prizes (Diane C.) Winners: 1-Mary Lou G., 2-Janet P., 3-Jane S.
- Show and Tell (Dona S.) Many beautiful quilts were displayed by our members.

Dona S. adjourned the meeting at 7:50 pm.

All placemats will be donated to Meals on Wheels of Ocean County








