#### Minutes of September 20, 2019 Meeting

The meeting was called to order at approximately 6:45 pm by President Dona S. Members were welcomed. As we were waiting on pizza delivery, the order of business was a little different than usual protocol.

Dixie M. and Marcia G. asked the winners of the 2018-2019 blocks of the month to present their quilts to the members. Nine of the ten winners displayed their quilts (May winner Jane S. was not in attendance, but it was noted she did finish her quilt.) Ballots were distributed to the members for a viewer's choice vote.

New members/guests Dianne W., Sherre M., Amy T. and Katherine M. stood and introduced themselves. Welcome!!

There will be no door prizes at this meeting as Diane C. was unexpectedly absent due to injuries suffered in a recent fall while running. We'll "double-up" door prizes in October.

President Dona S. reported the Island Beach State Park Beachplum Festival was a successful day for the guild. \$188.00 in Raffle Quilt tickets were sold and another \$327.00 was raised with the sales of various quilted and sewn items. Thumbs up!!

Dona S. asked for a motion to approve the minutes of the June 21, 2019 meeting. It was noted that a correction was needed, the winner of the UFO challenge was Janet P., not Jean P.

A motion to approve the minutes of the June 21, 2019 meeting as amended was made by Richard L. and seconded by Joyce W. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report was read by Debbie P. It covered the months of July, August and to-date for September. Beginning Balance: \$8,277.85 Total Receipts: \$2,345.31 Total Expenses: \$2354.95 Ending Balance: \$8,268.21 A Motion was made to approve report by Richard L. and seconded by Janet P. Motion passed.

- Charity Quilts: (Pat T./Barbara E.) Pat T. thanked the people who donated quilts for putting their names on the submissions so they can be properly credited to the maker. She has fabrics for those who wish to make charity quilts, and as always, was open to suggestions as to who could benefit from our donations. A question from the floor asked if there was a required size for the quilts. That may be the preference of the organization we are donating to but so far has not been an issue. Providence House (for women and children domestic abuse victims) was suggested. Sue B. said she was familiar with this organization and made it her personal goal that every child in the shelter at Christmas this year would get a quilt as a present. She would love it if other members joined her. The shelter director told Sue B. that the largest number of children in residence one Christmas was 20. They made no stipulation to the size of the quilts, and if we donate more quilts than there are children in residence this holiday season, they still can be used and appreciated. Other organizations were mentioned, including Quilts for Kids and the V.A. in Brick. Pat will investigate.
- **Budget**: Treasurer Debbie P. indicated that copies of the proposed 2019-2020 budget were on the tables. She noted that one change will be made, the Block of the Month funds will be increased from \$300.00 to \$500.00. The budget will be voted on at the October 18, 2019 meeting so everyone please take the time to read the information!

The pizza was delivered and along with subs from Jersey Mike's everyone enjoyed their dinner.

- Membership: (Jackie P.) The 2019-2020 membership list will be distributed at the October meeting. If you have any changes or corrections please get them to Jackie by October 1, 2019.

- **Programs:** Dona S. announced that the sign up sheet for the October 20, 2019, Erin Underwood Workshop "Dresden Tree Skirt" was at the front table. The workshop will take place at P.C.T.R.

Makerfest is schedule for Saturday, October 12. We are awaiting word if there will be a table available for the guild, so keep the date clear and Dona will notify the membership if we will be able to participate.

# **Charity Quilts**

For anyone bringing completed charity quilts to the October meeting, please be sure to have your name attached to the quilt (paper and safety pin) so we can be sure you get credit for your donation. We are very appreciative of the money, time, work, imagination, and effort that goes into creating charity quilts.

Also, if anyone has suggestions as to places that might like to receive our lovely charity quilts, please tell either Patricia T or Barbara E.

Marcia will continue to quilt Beachplum charity quilts. Please prepare your top as you would your own quilt, ready for longarming. Your top should be completed and pressed. Backing should be at least 4" larger than the top on all sides (i.e., 8" wider and 8" longer than the top). Please see the article on our website on How to Prepare your Quilt Top for Longarm Quilting. After your quilt has been longarmed, it will be returned to you for binding.

Charity quilt tops, prepared as above, can be brought to a meeting or dropped off at Crafty Fabrics. Batting is provided by the guild, and there is some backing available also.

Barbara E - quilting books and magazines


Kathleen C - notions, rulers, buttons, crafted items, etc.




