## How to Make a Quilt Sleeve

- 1. Cut a strip of fabric equal to the width of your quilt and 9" wide.
- 2. Fold the 9" ends under twice and stitch close to the edge. With the wrong sides together, sew the strip into a long tube.
- 3. Press the tube with the seam line on the bottom center.
- 4. Position the sleeve about one inch from the top of your quilt, on the back. The tube seam should be hidden, facing the back of the quilt.
- 5. Whipstitch the tube to the back of your quilt, being careful not to let the stitches show on the front.
- 6. Be sure to stitch down one layer on the ends of the sleeve to the back of the quilt so a hanging rod can be inserted and not touch the quilt itself.
